

Case of the Month: January 2023 Bin 604 Wine + Spirits

White:

Sauvignon Blanc Excelsior 2021 (South Africa) \$12.99

An inviting bouquet of passion fruit, lime and ripe fig lead to flavors of citrus, herbs and gooseberry on the palate. Zesty acidity and long fruity finish balance out this vibrant South African Sauvignon Blanc.

White Blend, LAB 2021 (Portugal) \$11.99

A blend of Moscatel, Sauvignon Blanc, Arinto and Fernao Pires with floral and tropical fruit aromas. Fresh and crisp, this wine has a friendly fruit profile of orange peel and lemon and balancing acidity. A perfect pairing for salted pork or roasted chicken.

Verdejo, Camina 2021 (Spain) \$10.99

Smooth, refreshing, and vibrant!! A fine example of one of Spain's native grapes. Flavors of lime, juicy melon, and hints of tropical fruit shine. The crisp clean finish will leave you wanting more!

Pinot Grigio, Gabriella 2021 (Italy) \$10.99

A classic Italian white with flavors of lemon, lime, pear, and a hint of golden apple. Splash a bit of this into your scampi and enjoy a big glass too!

Red:

Merlot, Lindeman's Bin 40 NV (Australia) \$10.99

Plum, blackberry, and a little dab of chocolate come together on a pleasant medium body. If you still hate Merlot because of Sideways, it's time to get over that!

Blend, Callia Bella Red 2021 (Argentina) \$9.99

What do you get when you blend Argentinian Malbec with Syrah?

Pure joy, that's what! Juicy and full-bodied with accents of blackberry, pepper, and vanilla. This won't last long in your glass.

Pinotage, M.A.N Family Wines 2020 (South Africa) \$11.99

With pleasant aromas of mocha and roasted coffee beans, it transitions to notes of juicy red-berries, nutmeg, and vanilla spice on the palate. Lighter in style than most Pinotage, it is a great match for spicy food, pizza, and smoked pork.

Tempranillo, Camina 2021 (Spain) \$10.99

Downright delicious! A fruit-forward style of Tempranillo with subtle hints of tobacco and leather behind a mix of red and black fruits. Tapa's anyone?

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Casalini 2020 (Italy) \$12.99

This easy evening sipper is the way to offset spicier foods and barbeque. Lighter in texture and tannin makes this a clear winner for any and all occasions, whether an impromptu get together or kicking back after a days work.

Pinot Noir, Black Ridge NV (California) \$9.99

This pleasant little Pinot has notes of cherry cola, spice, and cassis in a juicy round format with soft tannins. Perfect by itself or with salmon, roasted chicken, turkey and baked ham.

Red Blend, 19 Crimes 2020 (Australia) \$12.99

An easy-going blend with bright aromas of brambly berry, raspberry, and cherry with a dusting of cinnamon. A serious solid bargain that has a medium-body, and balanced, yet lingering finish.

Tempranillo, Finca del Castillo 2019 (Spain) \$8.99

Hailing from the warmer region of La Mancha, this bouncy Spanish red offers lots of spicy Tempranillo fruit, supported by light, crisp tannins on the finish. Go ahead and fire up that grill!
