# Lambrusco, Lunato NV (Italy) \$11.99

This light, refreshing Lambrusco is just pure fun! Surprisingly refreshing, with just a touch of sweetness. Serve chilled, drink often.

#### White:

# Macabeo, Collado 2021 (Spain) \$10.99

Pale yellow color, with vibrant green hints. Elegant nose of tropical fruit and citrics. Fresh, balanced and long in the mouth.

# Sauvignon Blanc, Line 39 2021 (California) \$12.99

This crisp and zesty Sauvignon Blanc has classic citrus and grassy notes, on a fresh and light body. Deliciously easy to drink, there's a reason we can't keep this on the shelf!

# Chardonnay, Line 39 2021 (California) \$12.99

Medium bodied with light toast and a fresh finish. Expect orchard fruit flavors with hints of vanilla.

#### Verdejo, Camina 2022 (Spain) \$11.99

Smooth, refreshing, and vibrant!! A fine example of one of Spain's native grapes. Flavors of lime, juicy melon, and hints of tropical fruit shine. The crisp clean finish will leave you wanting more!

#### Red:

# Garnacha/Syrah, Collado 2021 (Spain) \$10.99

Mouthwatering wild berry and black cherry intertwined with a little earth and black pepper on a silky texture. Pair with pizza, burgers and your favorite roast meats.

# Blend, Line 39 2020 (California) \$15.99

A blend of Petit Verdot, Petit Sirah, Merlot and Zinfandel, this wine is a great sipper for parties and dishes with lamb. Enjoy dark fruits with hints of baking spices.

# Merlot, Glenbrook 2021 (California) \$12.99

This friendly wine delivers rich aromas of dark plum, cola and sweet cherry. The palate is soft and packed with red and blue fruit, finishing with light oak spices.

# Cabernet Sauvignon, Glenbrook 2020 (California) \$12.99

The deep ruby red color with aromas of berries and cedar are the characteristics of this vintage varietal. It is a medium-bodied wine with just a hint of oak that is smooth, fruity and ready to drink. Pairs wonderfully with filet mignon, lamb, heavy pastas and cheeses.

# Tempranillo, Camina 2022 (Spain) \$10.99

A clean, bright and lovely wine with an attractive cherry red color. Red and black fruits such as raspberry, cherry and blackberry dominate the nose. Notes of almond and hazelnut are well-integrated throughout. Finishes fresh, round and well-structured.

#### Garnacha, Sabeo 2021 (Spain) \$11.99

Whether you're winding down by the fireplace or just need a happy hour pick-me-up, this medium bodied Garnacha will have you covered. Seriously, it's delicious. Enjoy flavors of cocoa, espresso beans, a hint of tobacco spice, and ripe purple berries.

#### Barbera, Bricco dei Tati (Italy) \$10.99

A bargain Piedmont that's also good? Go on... Deep cherry fruit harmonize with a touch of earth and a pinch of spice to produce a seriously over-achieving Barbera.
