

Case of the Month: March 2024

White:

Pinot Grigio, Alverdi 2022 (Northern Italy) \$11.99

A bouquet of freshly-cut acaia flowers is mirrored on the palate, along with notes of honeydew melons, green apples, and pears. A lovely and classic Pinot Grigio!

Sauvignon Blanc, Line 39 2021 (California) \$12.99

Opens with vibrant aromas of grapefruit and lemon with subtle grassy characters and a crisp clean finish. This wine is a fine accompaniment to shellfish or alone after a long day.

Blend, Gatao Vinho Verde NV (Portugal) \$9.99

One of the most familiar Vinho Verde brands in Portugal, this wine is medium sweet with a light prickle on the tongue. It is fruity with creamed apple and citrus along with a touch of honey. Slightly frizzante, the wine is crisp and clean, delicious to drink as an apéritif.

Verdejo, Marques de Caceres 2022 (Spain) \$12.99

From the Rueda region of Spain, this Verdejo is a real white wine drinkers treat with fresh floral notes and juicy pear. The clean and lively palate will keep you refreshed all winter long.

Chardonnay, Crane Lake 2022 (California) \$7.99 Expect flavors of citrus and green apples couples with melon and hints of vanilla. Super tasty and soft!

Rose:

Blend, Raza Vinho Verde Rosé 2022 (Portugal) \$11.99

The wine is bursting with red berry fruit, shows a slight spritz, as well as an intense freshness that is a direct result of the intrinsic characteristics of the native grapes. Perfect for a sunny afternoon!

Red:

Cabernet Sauvignon, Telios 2016 (California) \$15.99

Hints of chocolate and vanilla with ripe black fruit and spice surround the nose, leading to a smooth, rich palate with black currant, muddled blackberry, and raspberry. Time for steaks!

Pinot Noir, Line 39 2020 (California) \$12.99

A light, fresh Pinot with ripe red fruit and juxtaposing earthy mushrooms. Full of dark, brambly berries and just a touch of cocoa for a smooth and seductive finish.

Tempranillo, Finca del Castillo 2022 (Spain) \$9.99

A serious value from central Spain that offers fresh snappy cherries on a light body. An easy-going, everyday wine that is perfect by the campfire.

Garnacha, Honoro Vera 2022 (Spain) \$12.99

Juicy blackberry, plum, and raspberry notes all mingle together to make this medium-bodied and tasty red wine. Perfect for happy hour or to pair with grilled meats and Spanish cheese.

Barbera, Alverdi 2022 (Italy) \$10.99

This fruit-forward Northern Italy red is one of our favorites under \$15. Bright red in color and surprisingly rustic in style, with a profile of ripe cherries and blackberries..

Sweet:
