

## Case of the Month: April 2024

### White:

**Sauvignon Blanc, Bota Box 500mL x2 (California)**

**\$5.99**

What could be more refreshing than lime zest and lemon grass? With a zip of citrus, melon and a touch of minerality. Perfect for your next picnic or cookout.

**Chardonnay, Glenbrook 2021 (California) \$12.99**

The flavors are of ripe apple, pear, and citrus, with a hint of oak and butter. This Chardonnay is a great choice for any occasion, and pairs well with seafood, poultry, and light cheeses.

**Verdejo, Camina (Spain) \$11.99**

With aromas and flavors of green apple, pear, mango and a touch of honey, this wine is well balanced with refreshing acidity. Perfect for salads, vegetarian dishes and seafood.

**Orvieto, Lecciaia 2022 (Italy) \$ 11.99**

Fresh on the nose with a delicate and persistent bouquet. Very elegant on the palate; soft, fresh style with typical almond taste to the finish. A very easy drinking wine.

### Rose:

**Rosato, La Ferla 2023 (Italy) \$7.99**

This rosé made of Nero d'Avola and Nerello Mascalese grapes, is particularly pleasant and perfumed, polished on the palate, with a decisive mineral content.

### Sweet:

**Lambrusco, Lunato NV (Italy) \$11.99**

A fragrant, fruity sparkling Lambrusco. Light in body and well-balanced in style. Very refreshing with sweet red berry flavors making it a wine sweet wine.

### Red:

**Cabernet Sauvignon, Casillero del Diablo 2021 (Chile) \$13.99**

A wine that delivers the flavors of cherry and blackcurrant, together with a subtle touch of vanilla. On the palate it has a medium body with marked tannins, which lead the way for a long finish. This Cabernet Sauvignon is ideal when paired with grilled red meat and mature cheeses.

**Cabernet Sauvignon, Glenbrook 2020 (California) \$12.99**

The deep ruby red color with aromas of berries and cedar are the characteristics of this vintage varietal. It is a wine with just a hint of oak that is smooth, fruity and ready to drink.

**Pinot Noir, Trinity Oaks 2021 (California) \$12.99**

Strong aromas of juicy berries complement ripe red cherry flavors. This medium-bodied Pinot Noir with herbal notes and hints of violet has a smooth, toasty oak finish.

**Pinot Noir, Viejo del Valle 2021 (Chile) \$11.99**

Summer fruits of red currant, raspberry and wild strawberries on the nose follow through to a juicy palate. A touch of oak adds spice complexity.

**Tempranillo, Finca del Castillo 2022 (Spain) \$9.99**

This red has a flavor reminiscent of a good Cotes du Rhone. Medium bodied, flavorful; hints of raspberry and strawberry. Shows best with picnic fare and grilled meats. Perfect warm weather red.

**Monastrell, Sabeo 2020 (Spain) \$11.99**

Nose of black plum, kirsch, blackberry and vanilla and clove baking spice. The dry, full-bodied wine has a weighty mouthfeel with velvety tannin backing ripe black fruit flavors.
