

## Case of the Month: May 2024

### Sparkling:

#### **Glera, La Cavea Prosecco (Italy) \$13.99**

Tropical aromas of pineapple and crisp green apple lead to tongue-tingling citrus balanced by soft, delicate bubbles.

### White:

#### **Inzolia, Le Ferla 2023 (Italy) \$7.99**

Notes of white peach, lime, mint, lemon, and pine mingle with subtle minerality. A thoroughly tasty wine that bests most Pinot Grigios at a similar price.

#### **Verdejo, Baron de Breg 2021 (Spain) \$8.99**

Light and crisp with bright acidity, the notes of stone fruits, almonds, and a hint of citrus rind make this a lovely companion for the poolside.

#### **Pinot Grigio, La Cavea 2021 (Italy) \$10.99**

Softness and roundness with a lively personality, this wine seems to offer it all at a great bargain! Fresh aromas of lemon, pear, and apple.

#### **Riesling, Stone Cap (Washington) 2022 \$12.99**

Aromas of plum and peach mingle with light, fragrant notes of jasmine and orange blossom. Refreshing, bright acidity and flavors of juicy tangerine, white peach, and lemon zest.

#### **Cortese, Bricco dei Tati 2021 (Italy) \$10.99**

This is a lovely young fresh white wine, made from the grape Cortese, a very old varietal from Piemonte, Italy. It has a yellow apple taste and crisp acidity, which makes it ideal as a wine to sip before dinner or with seafood, salads, and white meat dishes.

### Rose:

#### **Barbera, Bricco dei Tati 2022 (Italy) \$10.99**

Fresh with aromas of strawberries, cherries and rose petals. This is ideal with shellfish, salads, chicken, and with appetizers.

#### **Malbec Blend, El Libre 2023 (Argentina) \$10.99**

This pink treat is made from Malbec, Torrontés, and Chardonnay. A fantastic crowd-pleaser with easy-going red fruits and a touch of spice.

### Red:

#### **Red Blend, Casa Santos Lima 2021 (Portugal) \$13.99**

This blend of indigenous Portuguese varietals is ripe with dark berries, hints of spice, and an earthy finish. A great pairing with a portobello mushroom burger!

#### **Cabernet Sauvignon, Mars & Venus 2022 (Chile) \$13.99**

This is a CLASSIC porch pounder for when the weather warms up. A juicy Cab offering flavors of cherry, chewy blackberry, hints of vanilla.

#### **Pinot Noir, 99 Vines NV (California) \$8.99**

This is a light, fresh Pinot with cherry, raspberry, and a little kick of spice. With the food versatility of this wine, it will even pair with your wacky uncle's corned beef and cabbage!

#### **Red Blend, Carro 2021 (Spain) \$12.99**

Aromas of cherry and licorice are complemented by a suggestion of dark chocolate, and a smoky nuance emerges slowly.
