

Case of the Month: October 2024

Bubbles:

Glera, La Cavea Prosecco (Italy) \$13.99

Tropical aromas of pineapple and crisp green apple lead to tongue-tingling citrus balanced by soft, delicate bubbles. Cheers!

White:

Pinot Grigio, La Cavea 2021 (Italy) \$10.99

Softness and roundness with a lively personality, this wine seems to offer it all at a great bargain! Fresh aromas of lemon, pear, and apple.

Blend, Stump Jump 2021 (Australia) \$15.99

A crisp, refreshing white blend, with a touch of sweetness. Tropical fruit nose, with mouth-watering lemon, lime and green apple flavors.

Blend, Protocolo 2023 (Spain) \$10.99

This straightforward, crisp white is 90% Arin, a little known indigenous varietal with 10% Macabeo blended in. Light apple and peach flavors mark this refreshing, light-bodied wine.

Blend, Chateau Cedre "Blandine le Blanc" 2023 (France) \$12.99

Straightforward nose that is slightly spicy and delicate notes of blossom and fruit cup. The palate is crisp with apple, pear and lemon juice notes.

Chardonnay, Excelsior 2023 (South Africa) \$13.99

This Chardonnay is a solid choice for your "house Chard." Honest and clean, with no oak, look for zesty lemon citrus and apple notes with a backbone of crisp acidity.

Rose:

Rosato, La Ferla 2023 (Italy) \$7.99

This rosé made of Nero d'Avola and Nerello Mascalese grapes, is particularly pleasant and perfumed, polished on the palate, with a decisive mineral content.

Red:

Merlot, Glenbrook 2021 (California) \$12.99

This friendly wine delivers rich aromas of dark plum, cola and sweet cherry. The palate is soft and packed with red and blue fruit, finishing with light oak spices.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Mars & Venus 2022 (Chile) \$13.99

This is a CLASSIC porch pounder for when the weather warms up. A juicy Cab offering flavors of cherry, chewy blackberry, hints of vanilla.

Tempranillo, El Cortijillo 2023 (Spain) \$9.99

A serious value from central Spain that offers fresh snappy cherries on a light body. An easy-going, everyday wine that is perfect by the campfire.

Garnacha, Honoro Vera 2022 (Spain) \$12.99

Juicy blackberry, plum, and raspberry notes all mingle together to make this medium-bodied and tasty red wine. Perfect for happy hour or to pair with grilled meats and Spanish cheese.

Malbec, Chateau Cedre Marcel 2022 (France) \$12.99

Medium bodied with flavors and aromas of black fruits, spices, mint and some fresh peppers.
