Case of the Month: April 2025

White:

Chardonnay, Primaterra 2022 (Italy) \$12.99

Clean, and pure, with apples and pears on the nose, a hint of residual sugar on the palate. A balanced, medium sized body, with a very clean and pleasant finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Primaterra 2022 (Italy) \$12.99

Pine with lemon and lime aromas on the nose of this easy white wine. Fresh on the palate with candied lemon zest and passion fruit, finishing with a wisp of a delicate floral note.

Trebbiano, Colle Corviano Trebbiano d'Abruzzo 2023 (Italy) \$11.99

Intense bouquet of ripe apples and peaches. Refreshing ripe apple and peach notes end with a gentle acidity. Perfect as an aperitif and well suited for shellfish and seafood in general.

Vinho Verde, Broadbent NV (Portugal) \$11.99

A long-time Bin 604 Staff fave, this wine is fruity with a light spritz on the tongue and notes of green apple, citrus, and minerals. Slightly frizzante, the Broadbent is crisp and clean, delicious to drink as an apéritif.

Macabeo, Collado 2023 (Spain) \$10.99

Elegant nose of tropical fruit and citrus. Fresh, balanced and long in the mouth. Delicious bargain bottle!

Rose:

Barbera, Bricco dei Tati 2023 (Italy) \$8.99

This amazing value wine is a no-brainer for your picnic basket! It's food-friendly and crowd-pleasing, with vibrant flavors of fresh cherry, strawberry, red currant, and rose petal.

Red:

Cabernet Sauvignon, Glenbrook 2021 (California) \$11.99

The deep ruby red color with aromas of berries and cedar are the characteristics of this medium bodied wine. Pairs wonderfully with filet mignon, lamb, heavy pastas and cheeses!

Pinot Noir, Les Jamelles 2023 (France) \$13.99

Endowed with beautiful ruby red color, Les Jamelles Pinot Noir reveals a nose redolent of berries, floral notes and a delicate hint of oak and vanilla.

Tempranillo, Finca del Castillo 2023 (Spain) \$9.99

Medium bodied, flavorful; hints of raspberry and strawberry. Shows best with picnic fare and grilled meats. Perfect warm weather red.

Garnacha/Syrah, Collado 2023 (Spain) \$10.99

Mouthwatering wild berry and black cherry intertwined with a little earth and black pepper on a silky texture. Pair with pizza, burgers and your favorite roast meats.

Blend, Flor d'Penalva 2021 (Portugal) \$10.99

Fresh aroma, with fruity notes of pine needles and wild flowers. In the mouth it has good freshness, body, smooth tannins and a pleasant finish, perfectly accompanying everyday meals.

Blend, Broadbent Vinho Verde Rosé NV (Portugal) \$11.99

It's still got the classic spritz that we know and love, with a bit more body than its white counterpart. Enjoy strawberry, pomegranate, orange zest as you cheers to warmer weather!
