Case of the Month: May 2025

Sparkling:

Glera, La Cavea Prosecco (Italy) \$13.99

Tropical aromas of pineapple and crisp green apple lead to tongue-tingling citrus balanced by soft, delicate bubbles. Cheers!

Whites:

Verdejo, Baron de Breg (Spain) \$8.99

Light and crisp with bright acidity, the notes of stone fruits, almonds, and a hint of citrus rind make this a lovely companion for the poolside.

Chardonnay, T.N.T. (California) \$10.99

Crisp and refreshing style with notes of pear and apple on the nose. A fine balance of citrus and vanilla with pleasant acidity to brighten the palate.

Sauvignon Blanc, Les Jamelles (France) \$13.99

Les Jamelles Sauvignon Blanc is taut and aromatic with flavors of passion fruit, wild strawberry, & pink grapefruit with a vegetal undertone. Fresh and minerally, with great acidity.

Blend, Vale Dos Pombos Vinho Verde (Portugal) \$8.99 Crafted by winemaker Carlos Treixeira, one of Portugals best

winemakers, this wine is the perfect way to start off the summer months with a bang. Notes of white flowers, peach, and grapefruit.

Pinot Grigio, Gabriella (Italy) \$10.99

Mouthwatering and delicate, citrusy and dry with a tangy finish with hints of nuts and toasted bread. An amazing bargain bottle year over year!

Reds:

Cabernet Sauvignon, Camelopard (Spain) \$10.99

Soft & inviting on the palate, with flavors of cherry, mulberry, anise & dark berry fruits with a hint of nutmeg spice. The finish is savory with robust tannins.

Merlot, Bulletin Place (Australia) \$10.99

Dark purple color with aromas and flavors of ripe and baked red fruits. Medium-bodied with smooth tannins. Serve with meaty casseroles, barbecue, and mature cheese.

Pinot Noir, Bulgariana (Bulgaria) \$16.99

Complex and lasting nuances of red and black berries, fresh jam and milk chocolate on the nose. The wine has a powerful, lasting taste with volume, length and velvety mildness. With the flavors of fresh cherries and a pleasant slight earthiness and a long finish.

Barbera, Bricco dei Tati (Italy) \$10.99

A bargain Piedmont that's also good? Go on... Deep cherry fruit harmonize with a touch of earth and a pinch of spice to produce a seriously over-achieving Barbera.

Malbec, Promesses de France Winemaker's Selection (France) \$13.99

Located southeast of Paris, Maison Jean-Claude Fromont produces authentic wine inspired by Burgundian tradition. This Malbec is fermented in stainless steel, resulting in a fresh, light-ruby colored wine with notes of freshly picked strawberries, spice, and black pepper.

Tempranillo, Bodegas Riojanas Canchales (Spain) \$13.99

Cherry-red with violet hues, brilliant. Fragant primary aromas. Fresh, fruity, varietal. Smooth and balanced in the mouth with slight tannins.
